SERIES OVERVIEW:

Who do you think you are? You might define your identity by the things people see on the surface — like your style, your look, your abilities, or your reputation. Those things might have something to do with who you are, but they don't quite capture the whole picture, do they? For each of us, there is always so much more to who we are beneath the surface. But who are we, really? How can we discover who God made us to be? And how can following Jesus shape who we're becoming? In this four-week series, we'll look at four moments from the early years of Jesus' life. As we do, we'll see how God helps us discover who we're becoming and how God's words help us discover who we are. We'll also learn how the right relationships help us discover how to grow and how Jesus helps us discover purpose.

THANK YOU . . .

This note is to say a sincere THANK YOU to everyone who worked at the Annual Food to Families Food Give Away on Monday, December 16. And to JAY (aka . . . J W) MOTSINGER, and DONNY and THE MT. PLEASANT YOUTH. Jay hauled the food from Food Lion to Mt. Pleasant in his enclosed trailer on Sunday night, and the Youth stayed at the church after their Christmas Party to unload over \$8,000.00 in cases of food. We couldn't do the Monday event without the help to get the food in the church on Sunday night.

The Food Give Away in an annual event that has been happening at Mt. Pleasant for over 20 years. Prior to the event the school social workers choose 50 families with the greatest need in the Ledford and Oak Grove school districts. The families receive the food about a week before the students get out for Christmas break. Many of these children wouldn't have enough to eat while they were out of school with out these food boxes. Every family gets two boxes of staple food items provided by Mt. Pleasant and Shady Grove brings refrigerated items that the families receive also. Mt. Pleasant and Shady Grove have worked together for several years to make this event happen.

Jesus told us to "Feed my Lambs". The Back Pack Ministry, where children receive food to eat over the weekend and the Food to Families which provides food while they are out for Christmas and beyond are opportunities to do what Jesus asked us to do. Thank you so much to everyone who supports the Back Pack Ministry, and to everyone who helped with the Food to Families event last Monday, just some of the ways we can be the hands and feed of Jesus!

Mission Committee

The Mission Committee has committed to feed homeless folks at the Cooperative Community Ministry (CCM) once a month (with the exception of December) on the 2nd Thursday of each month.

This is a great opportunity for families or small groups to serve together.

- **Living in Light of Eternity - led by Chris Clontz**

Join pastor Chris and dive deeper into 1 Thessalonians. Do you ever feel like your Christian faith has become stagnant, when you would rather be flourishing in your walk with Jesus? Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians can help with such a feeling. Its focus on Christ's return provides strength, encouragement, growth and maturity by providing hope in the middle of suffering, waiting and uncertainty.

Based on the book by Ann Spangler. This study focuses on the names and titles of God that will help you experience Him in fresh and deeper ways. We will do the Dave Ramsey study, Financial Peace University, for our Young Adult Small Group - FIYAH class.

Learn step by step how to budget, beat debt, save money, and build wealth for the future. No complicated blah blah blah here. FPU teaches simple, commonsense principles that work.

Don't be afraid to step out of your comfort zone, and into the Mt. Pleasant kitchen. We have meal opportunities coming up beginning Jan. 8 when Family Night resumes. For eight Wednesdays we gather as family and friends to enjoy supper together and to learn how to be more like Jesus.

Ideally, we serve a "homecooked" meal, reminiscent of times around Grandma's table with no to-go bags in sight. That means **we need volunteers**, from families who enjoy cooking to small groups to perhaps a cadre of friends willing to prepare, serve and clean up.

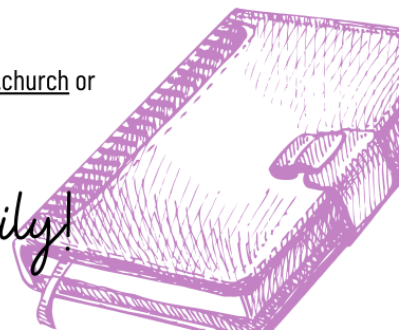
It is not nearly as scary as you might think. We have menu ideas, shortcuts and timing information. We have data collected from previous meals that can help calculate amounts.
