# **GROWING IN GRACE & KNOWLEDGE STEP BY STEP**

2 Peter 3:10-18

But the day of the Lord will come as unexpectedly as a thief. Then the heavens will pass away with a terrible noise, and the very elements themselves will disappear in fire, and the earth and everything on it will be found to deserve judgment.

11 Since everything around us is going to be destroyed like this, what holy and godly lives you should live, 12 looking forward to the day of God and hurrying it along. On that day, he will set the heavens on fire, and the elements will melt away in the flames. 13 But we are looking forward to the new heavens and new earth he has promised, a world filled with God's righteousness. 14 And so, dear friends, while you are waiting for these things to happen, make every effort to be found living peaceful lives that are pure and blameless in his sight. 15 And remember, our Lord's patience gives people time to be saved. This is what our beloved brother Paul also wrote to you with the wisdom God gave him—16 speaking of these things in all of his letters. Some of his comments are hard to understand, and those who are ignorant and unstable have twisted his letters to mean something quite different, just as they do with other parts of Scripture. And this will result in their destruction. 17 You already know these things, dear friends. So be on guard; then you will not be carried away by the errors of these wicked people and lose your own secure footing. 18 Rather, you must grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. All glory to him, both now and forever! Amen

It's easy to get distracted, worrying about our past and who we used to be. Or maybe it feels impossible to guard against worry about the future. Distractions and worries will always fight for our attention, but that doesn't mean we have to give in to them. At the very end of 2 Peter, Peter tells us to "be on your guard" and to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord."

Growing in a relationship with Jesus doesn't just happen by itself. Whether you're a new Christian or you've been a Christian for a while, growing is easier said than done.

There are days that we feel stuck or far away from God instead of closer to Him.

Rather than being concerned about when we will get through something, we can maintain focus on who promises to be with us through it all.

Because Jesus is patient, He doesn't give up on us. Because He is kind, He rescues us. Our current circumstances are temporary, but God always has good for us. We can grow the most with Him as we walk with Him through our circumstances, step by step. As we walk and grow He protects us from being 'carried away' by all the wickedness around us by keeping our footing secure.

- Living a Christ-like life: Seeking to embody the character traits and behaviors demonstrated by Jesus.
- Continuous learning: Actively studying the Bible and seeking to deepen your understanding of Jesus' teachings.

To live and be more like Jesus, you must know Him and His Word. Here are some practical ways to grow in your level of discipleship:

- · Worship with your church family regularly.
- Join or start a small group Bible study on Sundays or at other times throughout the week.
- Develop a daily Bible reading/study plan and a daily prayer plan.
- · Attend family night and participate in one of the four studies currently going on.
- Utilize MTP provided subscription to Rightnow Media to access a library of video Bible studies.

Developing these habits will help you grow in your discipleship and will change your life and your relationships. Resolve to deepen your discipleship in 2025.

#### **SERIES OVERVIEW:**

Those things might have something to do with who you are, but they don't quite capture the whole picture, do they? For each of us, there is always so much more to who we are beneath the surface. 


